Is diversity the only area of discussion where you have to know what's right before you even start learning

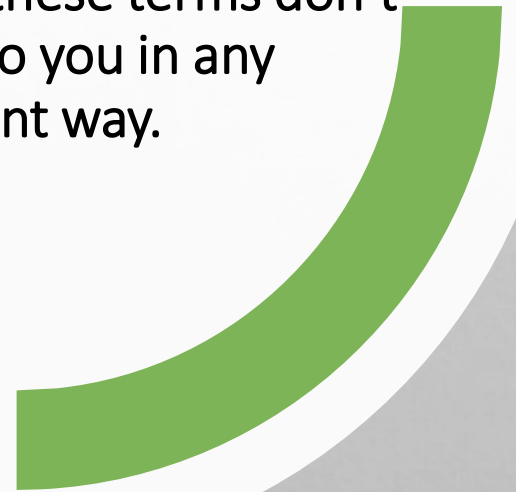
How do we stay kind when we talk about this — when we might really disagree



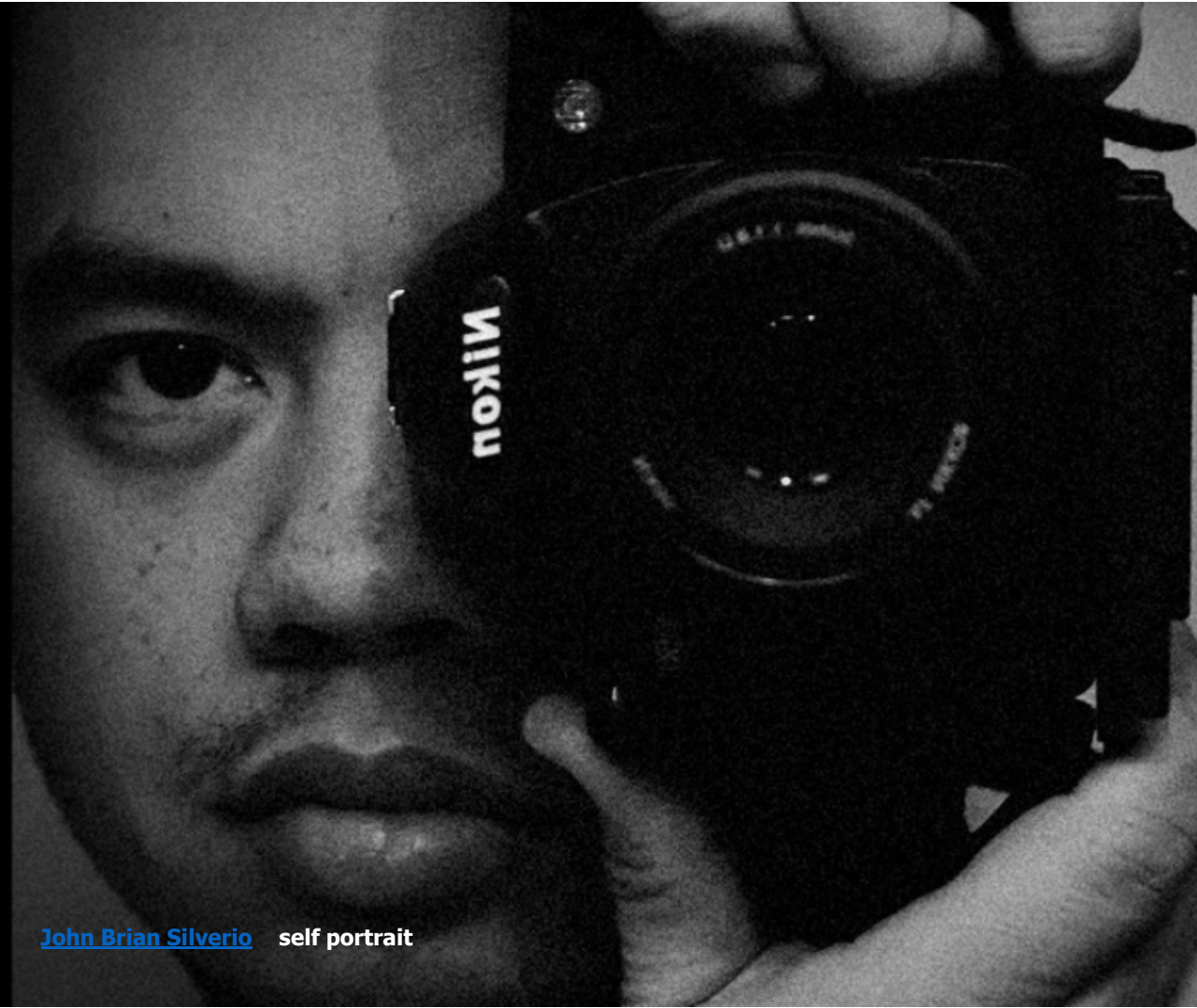


In what ways are you privileged/

- Introduced this discussion during induction
  - Students had been together for 2 days
- Catalysed wide ranging discussion
  - How do microaggressions make you feel
    - What might the intention be (exclusion or curiosity)
    - Where are you 'from-from'
  - What language do we use
    - Contested and mobile...finding a language that we can agree on (BAME, PoC)
    - How do we challenge one another
- Impact on the group dynamic and the learning throughout the life of the cohort
